CHURCH PICNIC

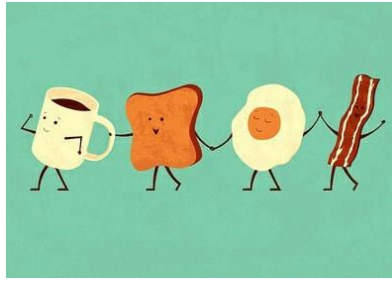
